

Girl Guides Lose Prominent Worker

NELSON, B.C., Jan. 30.—Mrs. E. J. Shardelow, 59, daughter of Danish nobility and known throughout British Columbia for her work with Girl Guide movement, died here Saturday after a lengthy illness.

Born in Copenhagen, the Baroness De Bretton, she came to Canada in 1903, settling at Whitewood, Sask., later moving to Winnipeg before coming here in 1921.

Mrs. Shardelow coached the Church of The Redeemer Guide troop here which in 1927-28-29 won the Dominion championship and the Murray-McLaren shield sponsored by the St. John Ambulance Association for junior home nursing.
