

GOVERNOR-GENERAL HOLDS INVESTITURE

More Than 20 Canadians Admitted to Order of St. John of Jerusalem

Ottawa, June 2. — (C) — The Governor-General as Knight Commander of the Order of St. John of Jerusalem presided over the third meeting of the Commandery-Chapter at Government House today and held an investiture at which more than 20 persons from various parts of Canada were admitted to different branches of the order. About 10 were present to receive their insignia personally.

During the meeting, C. G. Cowan of Ottawa, Lieutenant of the Commandery, gave a resume of the work in 1936 which showed an increase in every department. The Hospitaller and Almoner, Lt.-Col. Wodehouse of Ottawa, reported that the Canadian contribution to the work of the ophthalmic hospital in Jerusalem had been generously over-subscribed.
